## Room Assignability Code

- Assignable Occupied: Space that is assigned to and occupied by College Dept, Financial/ Administration or Facilities.
- Assignable Vacant: Space that is assigned to a College Dept, Financial/Administrative or Facilities Department but is vacant at the time of inventory.
- Non-Assignable All areas of a building not available for assignment to an occupant or for specific use, but necessary for the general operation of the building.
- Examples:
  - 1. Circulation -WWW (Codes)
    - Bridges/Tunnels
    - Elevators
    - Escalators
    - Loading Dock
    - Lobby
    - Public Corridor
    - Stairway
  - 2. Building Service Areas -XXX (Codes)
    - Custodial Supply Closet
    - Janitor Room
    - Public Restroom
    - Trash Room
  - 3. Mechanical Area YYY (Codes)
    - Central Utility Plant
    - Fuel Room
    - Shaft
    - Utility/Mechanical Space
  - 4. Structural Areas ZZZ (Code)

Structural Area = Gross Area – Net Usable Area (We do not use this code)
